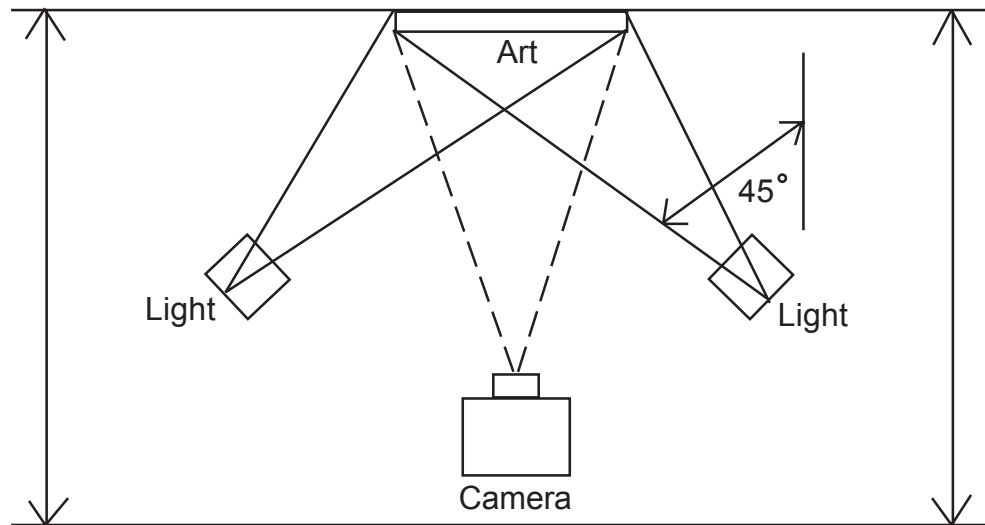


How to Photograph Your Artwork



- Art must be flat against wall.
- Camera must be parallel to wall.
- Always use a tripod.
- Use two identical lights set at 45 degree angle from the wall.
- Lights have “color temperature”. The kind of lighting will affect the way your art photographs.
- If using traditional photography, a larger format is better.
- 120mm is better than 35mm.
- 4 x 5 is better than 120mm.
- If using a digital camera use the highest resolution setting.
